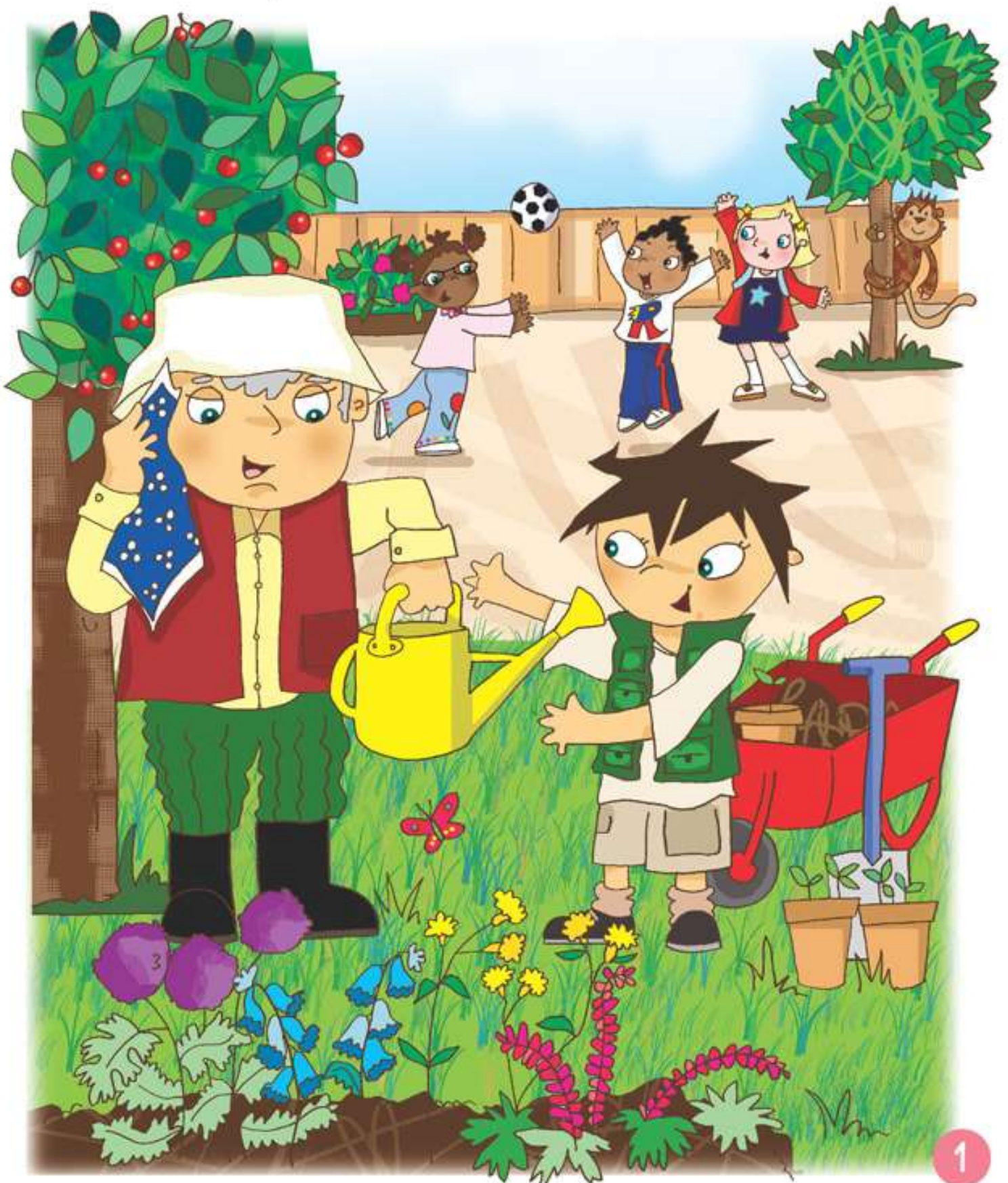

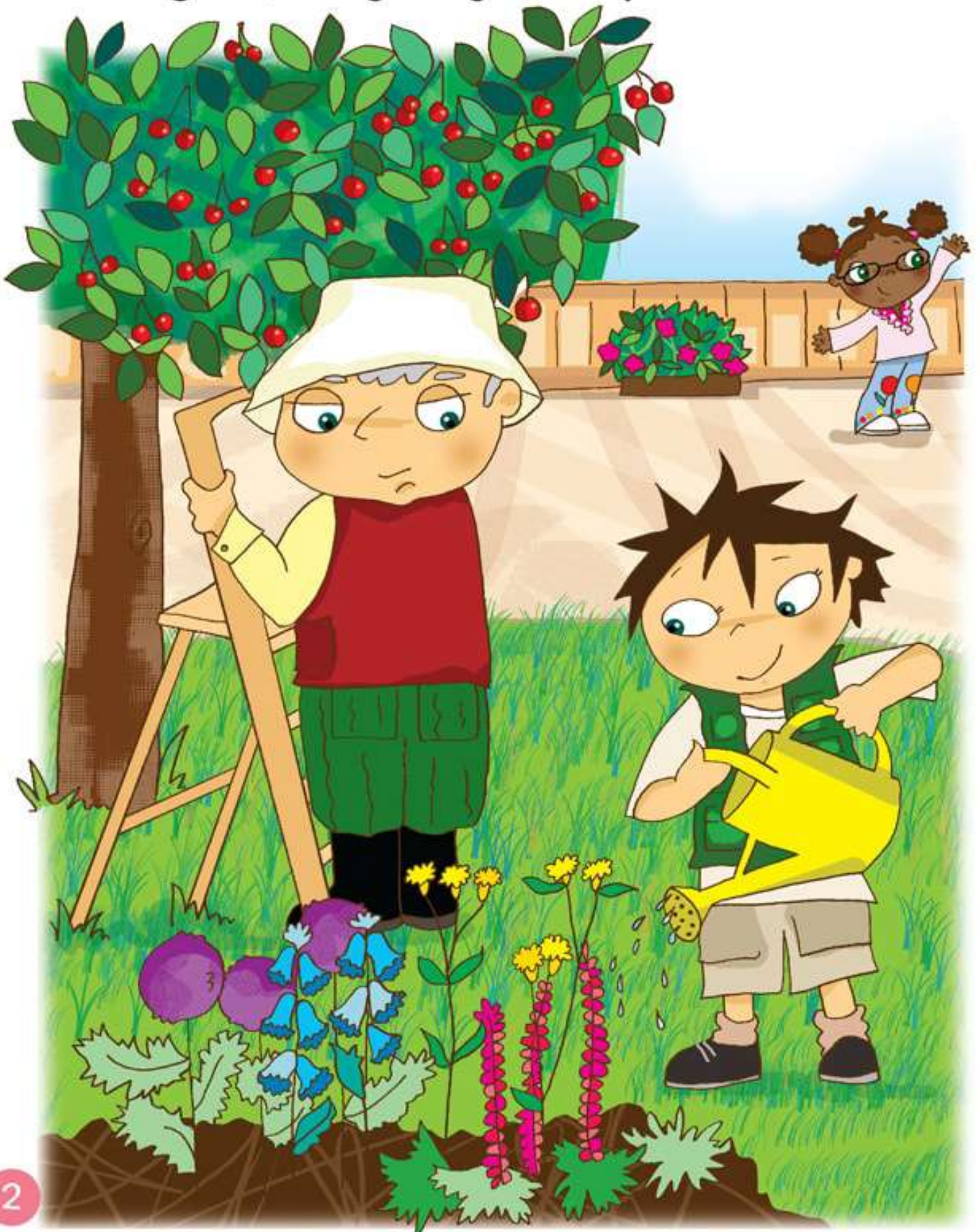

'That's good, Twig!' says Mr Pip.

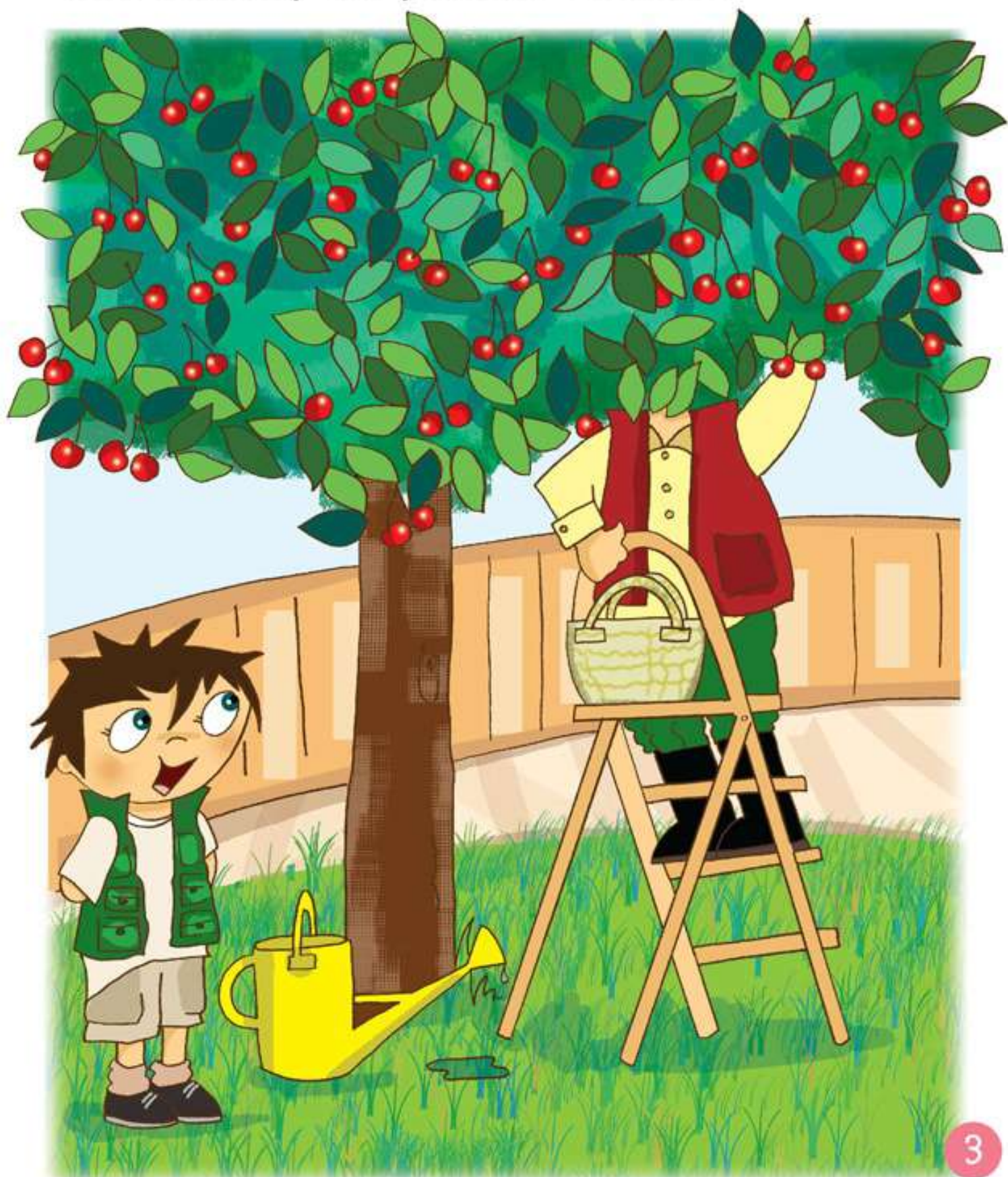


Mr Pip is very busy.

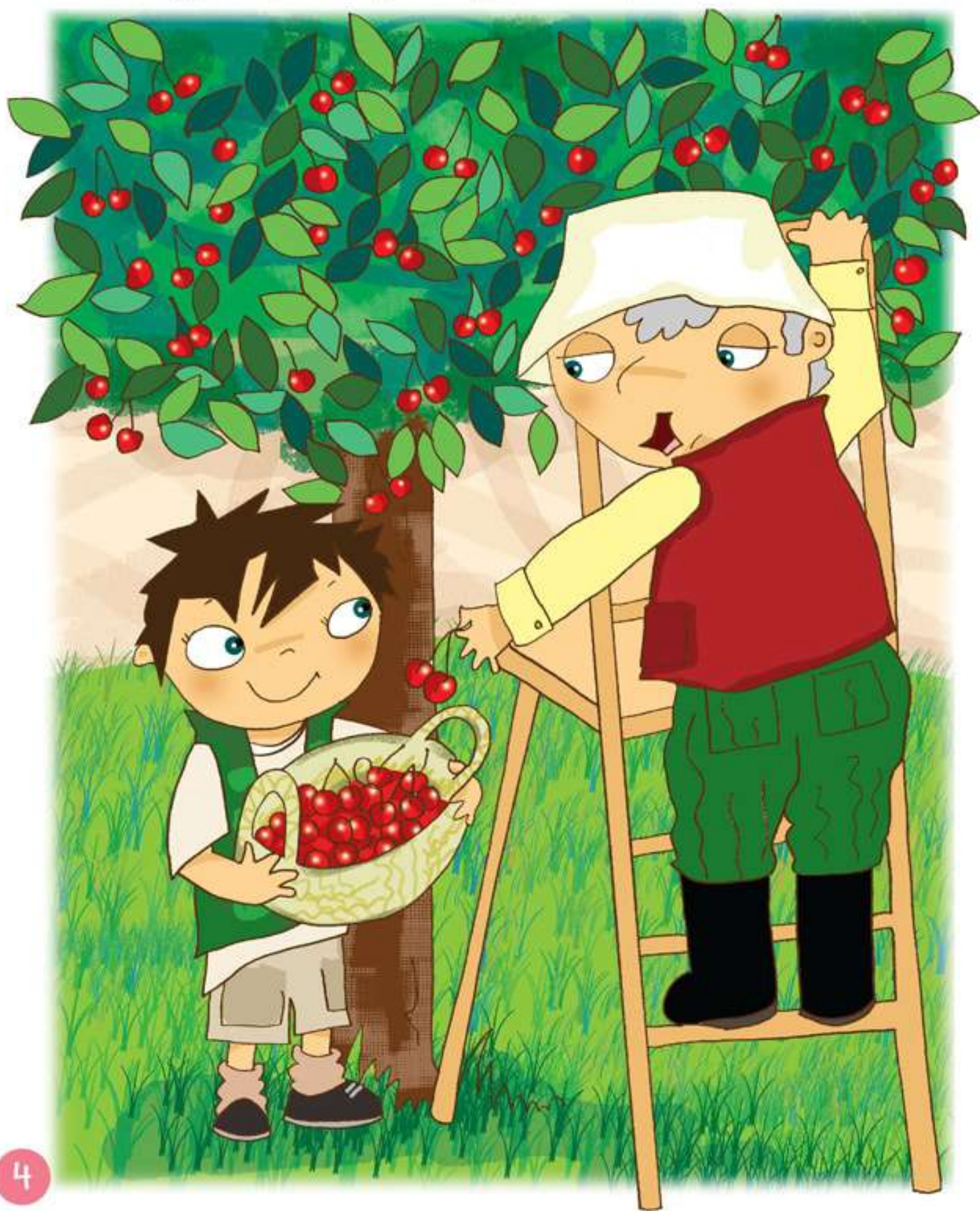
'Can I help you, Mr Pip?' asks Twig.

'Thank you, Twig,' says the gardener.

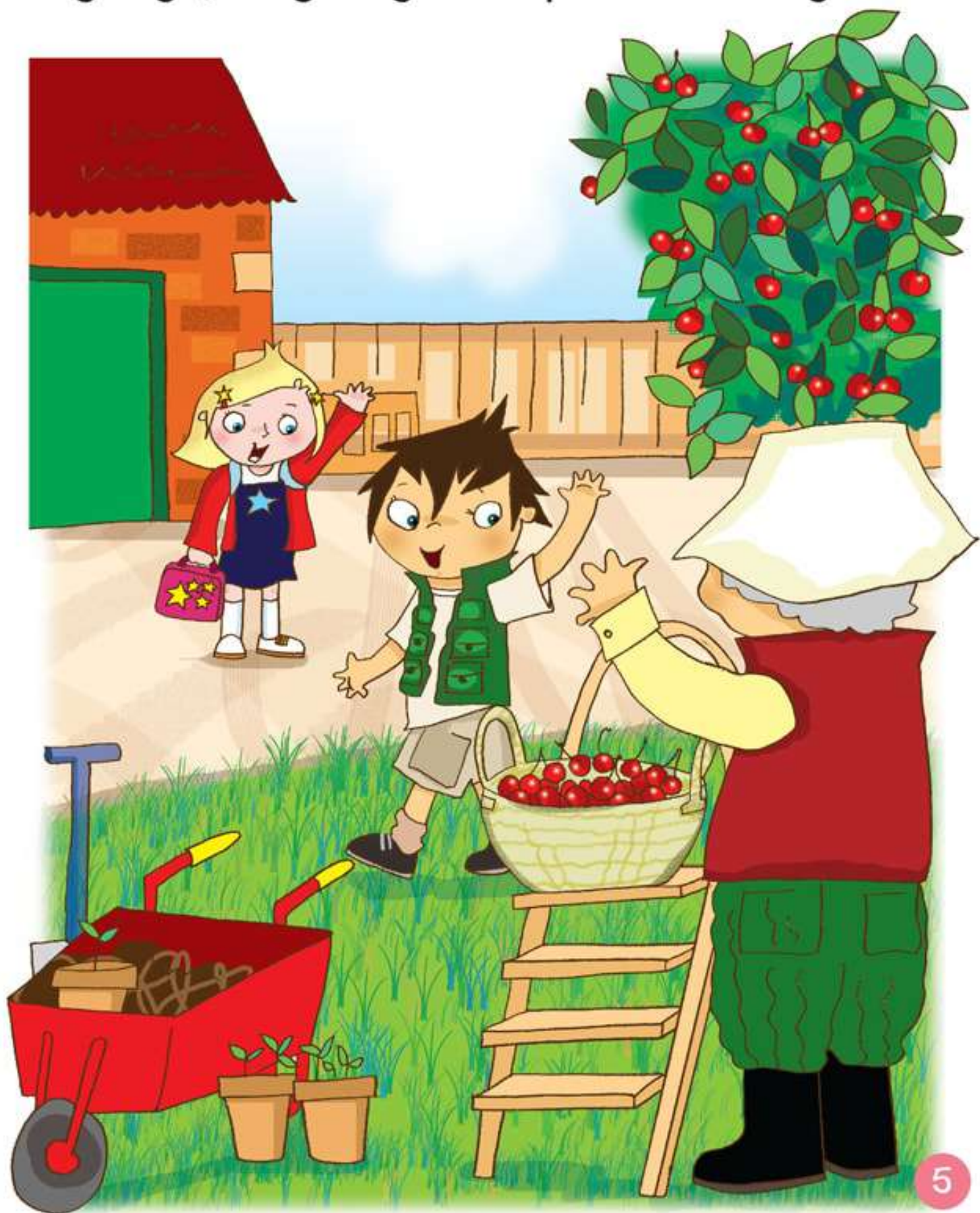
'You can help me pick the cherries.'

'Oh thank you!' says Twig. 'Cherries! Mmm!'

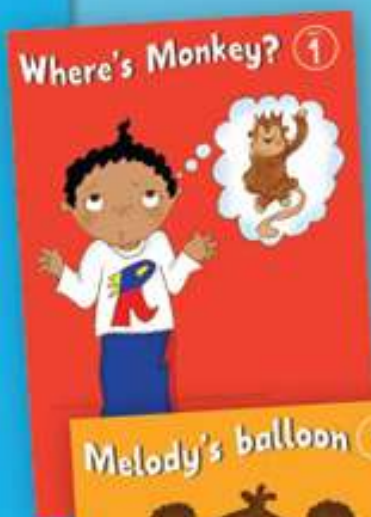
